GENERAL INFORMATION

- In the central body you will find the 17th-century farmhouse inside which are located the **Reception**, the **Restaurant** and the **Breakfast Room**.
- In the outdoor areas adjacent to the main farmhouse you will find a **saltwater pool with hydromassage stations - a multipurpose tennis and soccer field - a green spa - a children's play area**.
- In front of the restaurant there are two farmhouses where you will find the **12 Classic & Superior Rooms**, while the **14 Apartments** (with barbecue available) are 600 meters away and can be reached in 2 minutes by car from the reception.
- Many paths then connect the various areas of the structure, which in its **60 hectares of olive groves and woods** offers an unforgettable view of the Umbrian valley, starting from the hills on which Perugia stands, and extending to Assisi and Spello, nestled on the slopes of Mount Subasio.

THE OIL MILL

Inside the estate you will also find the olive oil mill with an avant-garde extraction plant where we produce our **extra virgin olive oil** every year. We organize guided tours of the mill (by reservation only during the olive oil campaign period between October and November) during which you can witness all the stages of olive harvesting and processing, discovering how extra virgin olive oil is born. Throughout the rest of the year at our Osteria Di Vin Porcello you can always order BREAD & OIL: a guided tasting of the different types of oil that you can then purchase at our point of sale at the reception in the main farmhouse.

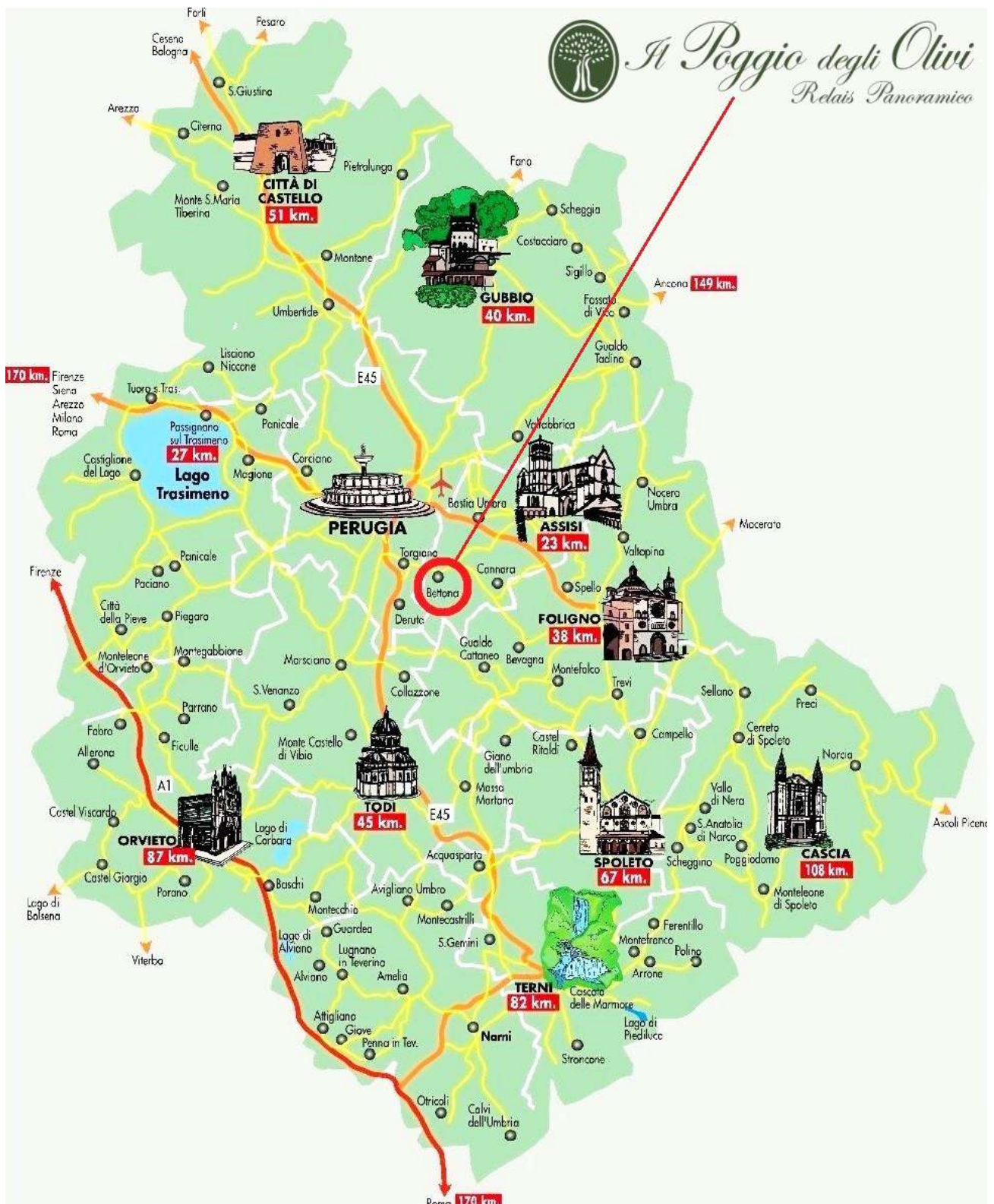

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THE SURROUNDINGS





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BETTONA



Bettona, "the Etruscan balcony of Umbria," is a charming medieval village with roots dating back to the Etruscan era, as evidenced by its well-preserved **Etruscan walls**. Within the historic center, you can visit the **Bettona City Museum**, housed in the Palazzo del Podestà, which houses important archaeological finds and an art gallery with works by Renaissance artists such as Perugino. Among the churches, the Church of **San Crispolto** stands out, the oldest in the village, and the **Oratory of Sant'Andrea**, which houses frescoes from the Giotto school. A walk along the city walls offers panoramic views of the Umbra Valley. Not far from the centre, there is the eighteenth-century **Villa del Boccaglione** and an **Etruscan hypogeum** in the hamlet of Colle.

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TORGIANO



Torgiano, a medieval village known as the "City of Wine and Oil," stands out for its profound food and wine culture. At the centre of its attractions are the two museums of the Lungarotti Foundation: the **MUVIT, Wine Museum**, which displays a large collection of finds that testify to the history and role of wine in Mediterranean civilization, and the **MOO, Olive and Oil Museum**, which illustrates the history and importance of the olive tree through the centuries. In addition to museums, you can explore the historic center with its 13th-century **Baglioni Tower** and various churches. As an important wine region, Torgiano also offers the opportunity to visit its wineries for tastings, such as those of the famous Lungarotti winery.

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ASSISI



Assisi, a famous Umbrian city and home of Saint Francis and Saint Clare, offers a concentrated on spirituality, art and history. An essential itinerary cannot ignore the **Basilica of San Francesco**, a Gothic masterpiece and UNESCO heritage site, with the Lower Church housing the tomb of the Saint and the Upper Church with Giotto's frescoes on his life. Other key stops are the **Basilica of Santa Chiara**, where they are the remains of the saint and the crucifix of San Damiano are kept, and the **Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli**, which incorporates the Porziuncola where Saint Francis lived. The heart of city life is **Piazza del Comune**, with the Temple of Minerva, an ancient Roman testimony excellently preserved. Finally, a walk to the **Rocca Maggiore** offers breathtaking views of the city and the valley below.

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SPELLO



Spello, one of the most beautiful villages in Italy, enchants visitors with its historic center medieval, famous for its balconies and flowery alleys that explode with colour, especially in spring and summer. Its Roman roots are still evident in ancient entrance gates, such as the **Porta Consolare** and the **Porta Venere**, with the Torri di Properzio. Among the main points of artistic interest, the Church of Santa Maria Maggiore stands out which houses the magnificent **Baglioni Chapel**. Here, you can admire a cycle of frescoes by Pinturicchio and paintings by Perugino, as well as a precious floor in Deruta majolica. Also unmissable is the **Villa dei Mosaici**, where the remains of a rich Roman villa with exceptional mosaic floors are visible. Going up towards the most high of the village, you can enjoy splendid panoramic views of the surrounding valley.

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TREVI



Trevi, a medieval village known as "the city of oil," is perched on a hill overlooking the Umbrian plain. Among its main attractions is the **San Francesco Museum Complex**, which houses an art gallery, an archaeological collection and the 16th-century nativity scene of "Spain". Another point of interest is the **Sanctuary of the Madonna delle Lacrime**, where you can admire Perugino's valuable fresco cycle from 1521 and the fresco of a pupil of "Spain". For history buffs, **Villa Fabri** with its gardens offers spectacular panoramic views of the valley, while the **Museum of Olive Civilization** celebrates the area's olive oil tradition. There is no shortage of characteristic squares such as **Piazza Mazzini** and historic churches such as the **Church of Sant'Emiliano** and the **Convent of San Martino**.

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SPOLETO



Spoletto, an art city rich in history and culture, is famous for its imposing historical heritage. The **Rocca Albornoziana** and the majestic **Ponte delle Torri** dominate the city of the Towers which connects the fortress to the Monteluco forest. The historic center culminates in **Piazza del Duomo**, where the **Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta** is located, with its frescoes by Filippo Lippi and its façade adorned with a mosaic. Walking through the streets, you discover other jewels such as the ancient **Roman Theatre**, the **Roman House** of Vespaia Polla and the **Arch of Drusus**. There is no shortage of lively squares, such as Piazza del Mercato and the evocative route of the former Spoleto-Norcia railway for lovers of nature walks.

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TODI



Todi, a charming medieval village overlooking the middle Tiber Valley, is famous for its superb architecture centered around the scenic **Piazza del Popolo**, considered one of the most beautiful in Italy. Overlooking the square are the **Palazzo del Popolo** and the **Palazzo del Capitano**, examples of medieval public architecture that today house the Civic Museum. The square is dominated by the facade of the **Co-Cathedral of the Santissima Annunziata**, built in the 12th century. A short distance away, in an elevated position, is the **Church of San Fortunato**, a Gothic building that preserves the tomb of the poet Jacopone da Todi in the crypt. Absolutely not to be missed is the **Temple of Santa Maria della Consolazione**, a masterpiece of architecture Renaissance with a central plan, located just outside the city walls.

ORVIETO



Orvieto, an art city built on an imposing tuff cliff, is a true Umbrian jewel. In addition to the magnificent **Duomo**, a masterpiece of Italian Gothic with its mosaic-shining façade and extraordinary depictions of the **Last Judgement** in the Chapel of San Brizio, the city offers other treasures. A must-see is **St. Patrick's Well**, a 16th-century hydraulic engineering feat designed by Antonio da Sangallo the Younger, with its double spiral staircase that allows you to descend and ascend without ever meeting. Beneath the city winds the fascinating **Orvieto Underground**, a dense network of caves and tunnels dug into the tuff that reveal another city, made up of cellars, oil mills and cisterns, testimony to its long Etruscan and medieval history. For a 360-degree view of Orvieto and the surrounding countryside, you can climb the **Torre del Moro**. Finally, one should not forget to visit the **Albornoz Fortress**, with its park, to admire the city and its surroundings from another perspective.

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BEVAGNA



Bevagna, an enchanting medieval village nestled in the Umbrian Valley, offers a evocative journey back in time. The heart of city life is the splendid and symmetrical **Piazza Silvestri**, overlooked by the **Palazzo dei Consoli** with the adjoining Francesco Torti **Municipal Theatre**, the **Church of San Silvestro** and the **Church of San Michele Arcangelo**. The city's Roman origins can still be seen in the remains of the Roman Theatre and in the **Roman Baths**, which hold a magnificent mosaic. Every June, the village comes alive with the famous **Gaite Market**, a medieval historical reenactment that brings ancient crafts and traditions of the time.

GAITE MARKET IN BEVAGNA



The **Gaite Market** is a medieval historical reenactment which takes place in Bevagna for 10 days in the month of June and draws inspiration from the ancient division of Bevagna into four districts (called gaite) on which the organization of the city in medieval times was based.

The aim of the event is to reconstruct with the greatest historical relevance the daily life of the inhabitants of Bevagna between 1250 and 1350. The **ancient medieval craft workshops** reopen their doors and resume activities in period clothing and the citizens experience the daily lives of their ancestors by eating, working, playing just like them.

The **spirit of competition** is the basis of the event and takes the form of participation in **4 competitions**:

- **Market**
- **Crafts**
- **Gastronomy**
- **Archery**

With a complex points system, on the last day of the event the winner is declared and the **victory pole** is donated.

MONTEFALCO



If you visit Montefalco we recommend you do not miss some symbolic places that tell the story and soul of the village. The **Church-Museum of San Francesco**, famous for the frescoes by Benozzo Gozzoli, is still visible from which you reach the evocative **Piazza del Comune**, with the town hall, the **former church of San Filippo Neri** and the **Oratory of Santa Maria**. From here it is worth continuing towards the **Church of Santa Chiara della Croce** and the nearby little **church of Santa Croce**: all of them are small masterpieces of Umbrian art. The Augustinian Monastery of Santa Chiara completes the route with its cloisters and a walk along the medieval walls, interspersed with the **ancient gates** that frame the panorama over the Umbrian valley.

PERUGIA



The historic center of Perugia is a fascinating intertwining of medieval alleys, scenographic squares and monuments that tell over two thousand years of history. Among the places of greatest interest stands out **Piazza IV Novembre** where the famous **Fontana Maggiore** stands. In the background is the majestic **Cathedral of San Lorenzo**, flanked by the **Palazzo dei Priori**, now home to the National Gallery of Umbria. Walking along **Corso Vannucci** you meet elegant historic buildings, cafes and shops, until you reach the **Carducci Gardens**, from which you can enjoy a breathtaking view of the Umbrian valley. Also not to be missed are the **Etruscan Arch**, an ancient monumental gate dating back to the 3rd century b.C., and the evocative **Rocca Paolina**, a Renaissance period fortress within which winds a fascinating **underground route**.

LAKE TRASIMENO



Lake Trasimeno, the largest in central Italy, is a quiet place and evocative, surrounded by rolling hills, olive groves and historic villages. It offers views romantic, unspoiled nature and a relaxing atmosphere ideal for walking, sports and boat trips.

GUBBIO



Gubbio is one of the best-preserved medieval cities in Italy, nestled on the slopes of Mount Ingino. Its historic center, full of stone palaces, steep alleys and scenic squares, is a tale of a fascinating past linked to dukes, crafts and ancient traditions, such as the famous Festival dei Ceri. The unique atmosphere and authenticity of the village make it an unmissable destination in Umbria.

MARMORE FALLS



Taking the Valnerina state road from **Terni**, after just 7 km you reach the **Cascata delle Marmore**, a fundamental stop for anyone who decides to visit Umbria's natural beauty. The Marmore Falls is an artificial hydraulic system built by the Romans; the Velino River, in fact, widened in the years preceding 290 b.C. into a vast area of stagnant waters, marshy and unhealthy. In order to let these waters flow, the consul Curius Dentatus had a canal dug to channel them towards the Marmore cliff, and from there he made them fall, with a total leap of 165 meters, into the bed of the Nera River below. For about 50 years the waters of the waterfall have been used to feed the Galleto hydroelectric power plant. As a result the waterfall can be admired **only at certain times**.

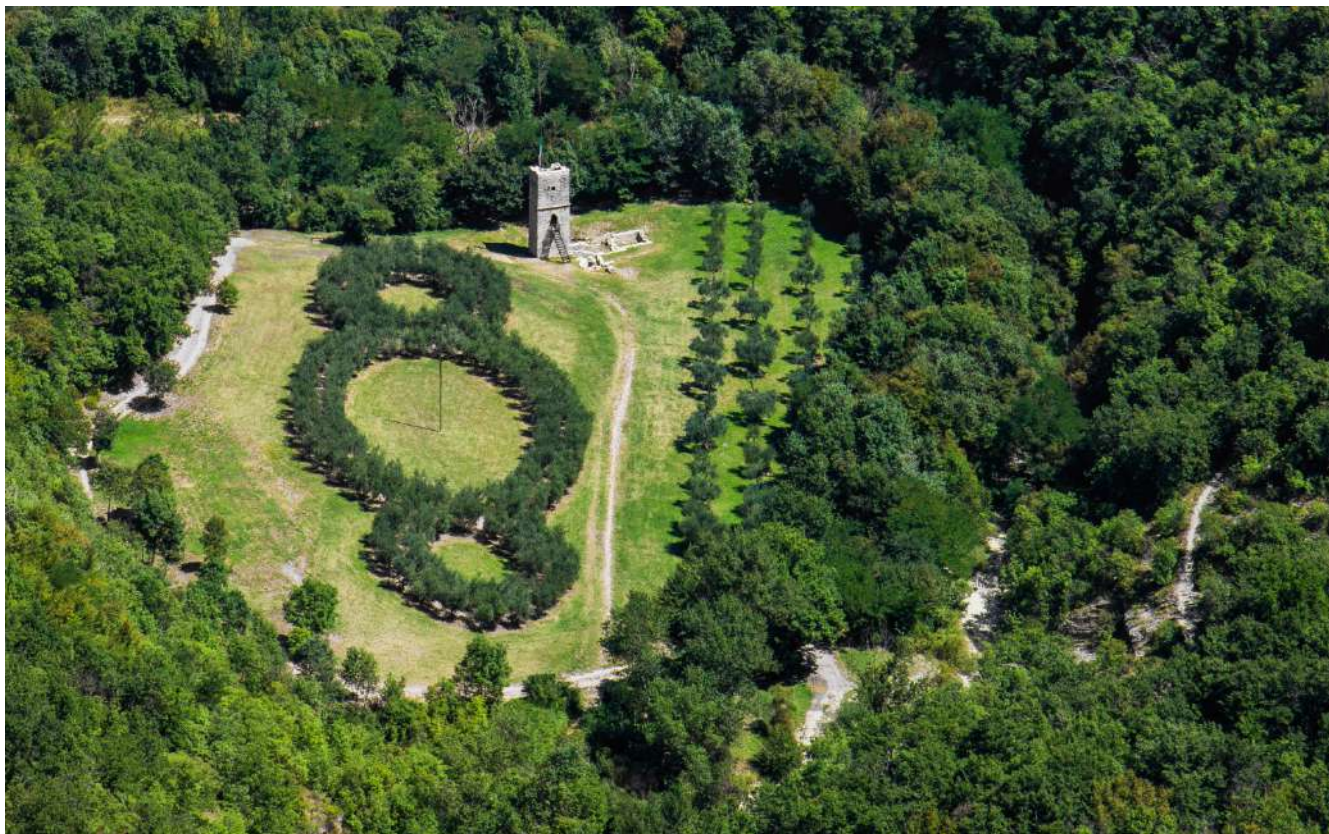
